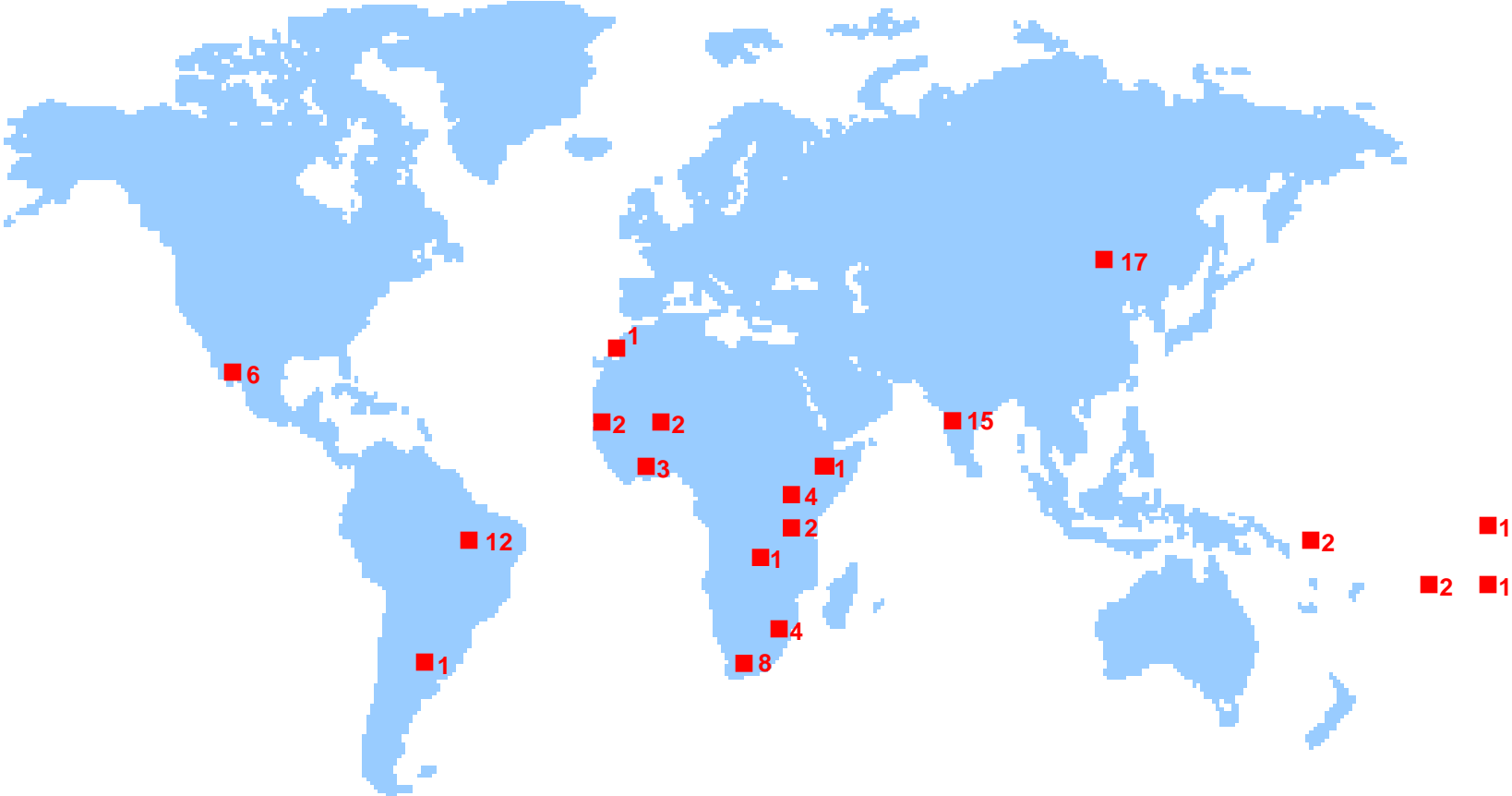
# What's REEEP

---



- Global public private partnership active in low carbon energy – RE & EE;
- Launched by UK in 2002 – established 2004 by UK and Austria – WSSD/JPoI and G8 RE task force
- 340+ partners, 46 Govts.
- Major support – UK, Norway, Australia, Ireland, Italy, US, Germany, Austria, Spain, NZ.
- 129 projects over 5 years, - 50 countries.

# REEEP low-carbon energy projects - 129 in 56 countries



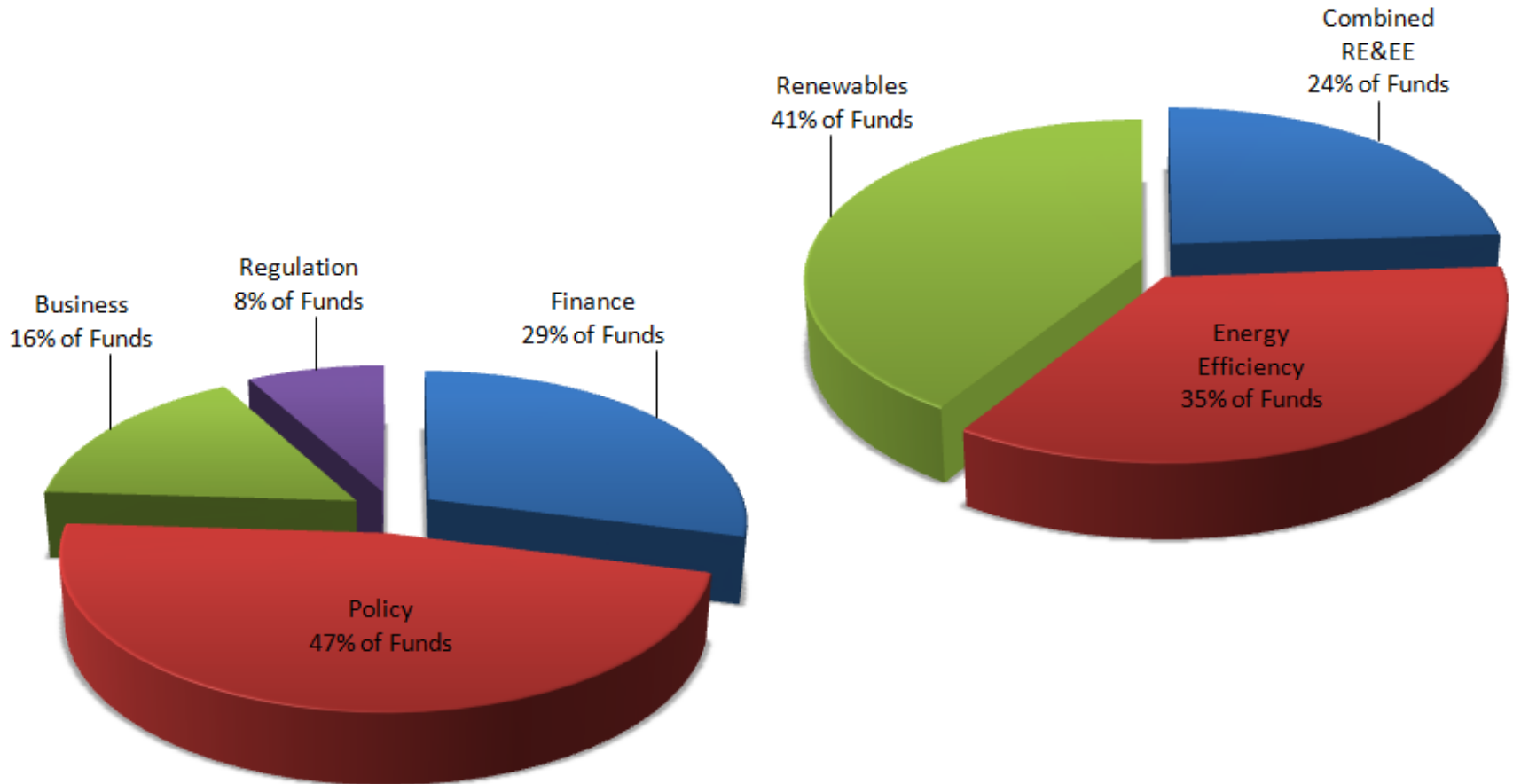
# Examples of Projects and initiatives

- Reegle – search engine

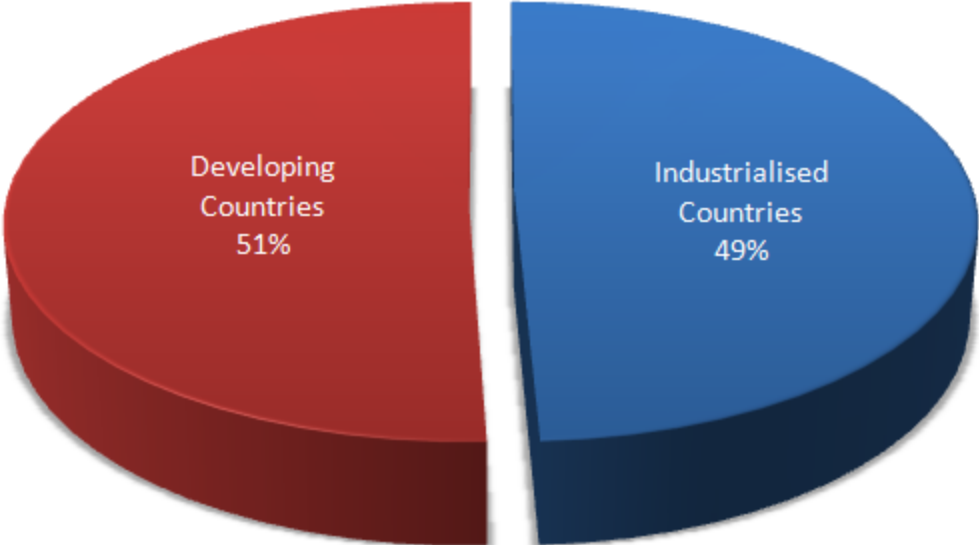

# Location of implementing partners

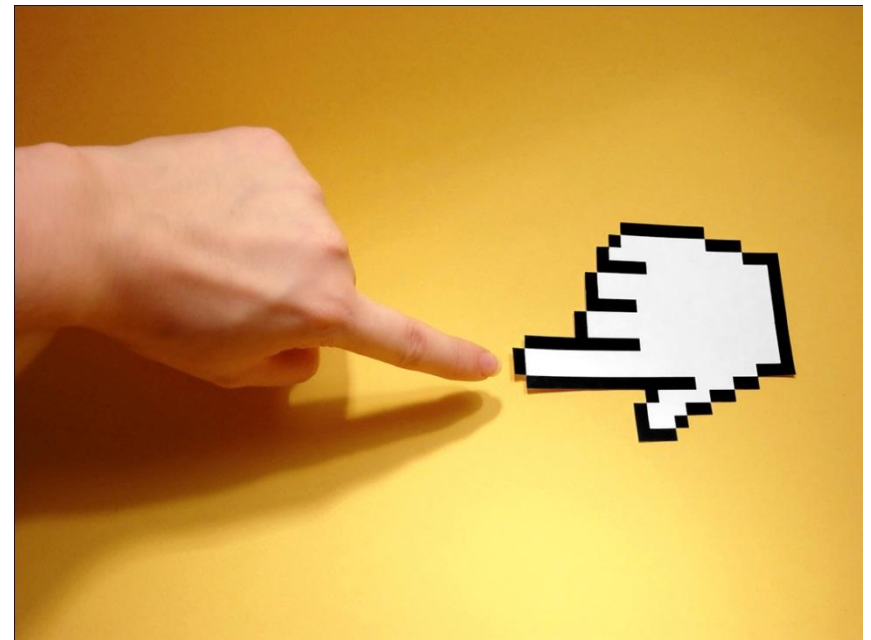

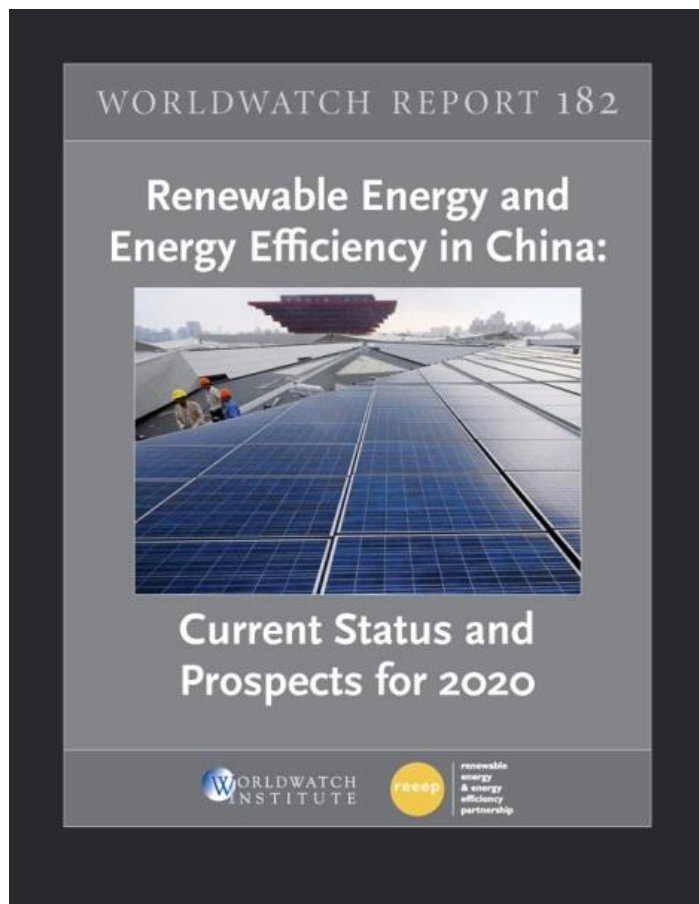
# Lessons on process

---

- Ownership of outcomes and impacts – Country driven.
